

The cleaning of mineralit - balcony floor slabs and stair steps

Basically, similar requirements apply to the cleaning of mineralit slab elements as to the cleaning of natural stone. Here only little can be done wrong, because mineralit - tile elements are just as hard-wearing, insensitive and easy-care.

Nevertheless, the following care instructions should be observed, because only with correct treatment can their properties be fully exploited and a problem-free permanent load is made possible.

In outdoor areas, regular cleaning is particularly important in order to avoid incrustations of dirt. Mineralit can usually be cleaned thoroughly and quickly by washing with stone or soft soap.

For the cleaning of balcony floors and stairs, commercially available detergents or all-purpose cleaners which are added to the cleaning water in small doses or wax-free care products for artificial and natural stone are best suited.

Uncoated decors: Care should be taken with low-viscosity oils and strongly colouring liquids, as they may penetrate deep into the material and permanently change its appearance.

Please do not use any layer-forming care products (containing acrylate or wax) in order not to impair the appearance and properties of the surfaces. Acid- and chlorine-containing cleaning agents should also be avoided.

Removal of special soiling

Oil stains, grease, paints, lacquers, felt-tip pens or wax can usually be removed with an intensive cleaner. In stubborn cases, LÖSEFIX wax and Oil remover.
